TERMS AND CONDITIONS

REGISTRATION FEE. Includes admission to the sessions registered for, program material for such sessions, breakfast snacks, coffee breaks, and opening night reception.

CANCELLATION AND REFUND POLICY. A refund (less an administrative fee of \$40.00) will be made if notice of cancellation is received in writing before April 30, 2019. We regret that **no refund will be given after this period.** A substitute delegate is permitted only if the substitute delegate provides the same type of information that the original delegate supplied at registration (contact information, professional discipline), accepts registration on these terms and conditions, and satisfies the registration requirements set out below.

ATTIRE. Recommended attire for the conference is business casual.

REGISTRATION AND ACCESS RESTRICTIONS. The conference is intended to provide training to individuals engaged in the field of law enforcement, legal services, social work, social services, children's advocacy, education, counselling, therapy, probation or medicine. All registrants must provide the Canadian Centre with their professional discipline and the name of the organization they work for or are associated with, within the registration form. A registrant **must** be an employee, board member, or proprietor of (or provide services to) the organization named on the registration form of the registrant; and must be authorized to practice the profession identified on the registration. Student registrants in the listed fields may be admitted at the discretion of the conference organizer, and **must** be a student of the educational institution named on the registration form of the student registrant. *Due to the sensitive nature of the information presented at the conference, the Canadian Centre reserves the right to restrict access to the conference and to certain presentations.*

RIGHT TO REJECT REGISTRATION, REFUSE ENTRY, OR EJECT PARTICIPANTS. The Canadian Centre reserves the right to reject any registration prior to the date of the conference without explanation by notifying the individual concerned by email or mail and refunding 100% of the registration fee paid. It also reserves the right to refuse entry to a registrant or to eject a participant from the conference or from a presentation without explanation. If entry is refused, 100% of the registration fee paid will be refunded. If the registrant is ejected from the conference or a presentation, the amount of the registration fee that will be refunded will be pro-rated based upon how much of the conference the registrant has already attended and whether or not the participant returned the conference materials in reasonable condition and within a reasonable time.
